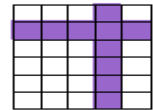

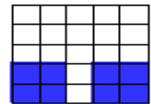

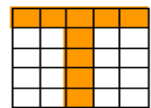

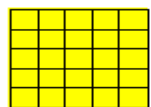

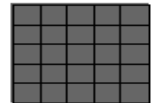

#### House Rules

- 1 Children are welcome to play when accompanied by an adult and do not disturb other players. The adult must take responsibility for the child's behavior. Management reserves the right to ask you to leave if this common sense rule is ignored, No refunds will be made.
- 2 No person under 18 years of age may purchase any games of chance. Children under 18 may play if the games of chance are purchased by an adult at least 18 years of age.
- 3 After the caller has asked for any other bingos, then declared the games closed, no other bingos will be recognized or paid. It is your responsibility to get the volunteer's attention when you have won a bingo.
- 4 Winning jar raffle tickets must be presented for payment the same day as purchased.
- 5 In accordance with the state rules and regulations, the last number called is not a requirement for a good bingo.
- 6 Each person must have a tally sheet and receipt of pack purchases to win. No splitting packs between players per state regulations.
- 7 In order to play Progressive and Double Actions you must purchase at least one regular pack.
- 8 Animals may be approved if quiet and no bother to other players, No animals allowed except service dogs at a "must go".
- 9 No stacking chairs or reserving chairs at a "must go".
